COOKIES POLICY

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

The different categories of cookies include:

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of a website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of a website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.

Analytical or performance cookies. These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to a website. They enable personalisation of content, such as greeting by name and remembering preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Targeting cookies. These cookies record visits to a website, the pages visited and the links followed. This information might be used to make a website and any advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.

You can find more information about the individual cookies **We use** and the purposes for which we use them in the Table below:

Cookie Title and Name	Purpose
_lscache_vary (Litespeed)	This cookie is used to optimise the serving of cached pages to users based on their custom preferences or browsing behaviour. It helps enhance website performance and load times.
PHPSESSID	This cookie is native to PHP applications. The cookie stores and identifies a user's unique session ID to manage user sessions on the website. The cookie is a session cookie and

will be deleted when all the browser windows are closed.

We are operating an 'implied consent' policy which means that we assume you are happy with our cookie usage. If you are not happy with this, you can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse or disallow the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.
